The Uniersity respond to anysuch requests one calendar month as is defined by Information Commissioner's Office guidance. Where a request is deemed particularly complex this period can be extended by a further t circumstances DMU shall inform the data subject of anysuch extension month of receipt of the request, together

To help us locate the information, the request should include the data subjects name (and anyother names they have been kno eleant), the period for information relates (the calendar yar(s), or academic yar(s) for students), the date of birth, the address at the time, and the DMU identification number (if releant). In addition information such as the facultythe indiidual studied or directorate they

We send the information to you byemail in an encrypted of format unless you specify an alternatie.

We normallyneed to erifythe identity of the requestor and hence mayneed to see eidence of their identity. We ask for photo ID such as passport or drier 's licence if possible, or a birth certificate or other approved. ID if this is not possible. This information

The fact and details that a data subject sent or receied an email, and the subject line and date is deemed that person's personal data, the contents of those emails are not unless theyinclude specific additional information concerning that person.

Third Party Requests

The Data Subject can ask a third party(for example a solicitor) to make a SAR on their behalf. We wact on the Data Subjects behalf if they us identity w

Please note, the timeframe of a calendar month of the information that is being requested, **and** confirmation of either the Data Subjects identity or confirmation that a third party's entitled to act on their behalf.

Requests from official bodies

Where requests are receied for the personal data of indiiduals from bodies that hae a legal right to access the personal information of the Data Subject
